

PROJECT PROPOSAL

COMMUNITY CAPACITY BUILDING

1) PURPOSES

- a) To provide practical support for Ventnor's extensive and varied third sector organisations and their engagement with the future development of the town.
- b) To advise on sources of appropriate funding for their operations and activities and assist with the preparation of related bids for them.
- c) To respond positively to requests for assistance ranging from advice on organisational structures and practices to practical involvement in the administration of particular projects.
- d) To develop and maintain a database of third sector organisation as the essential resource for continuing communication and co-operation.

2) THE THIRD SECTOR

- a) The initial stage of the town council's community engagement strategy not only revealed the surprisingly large number of voluntary and community organisations among a population of little over 6,000 but also demonstrated an encouraging enthusiasm to engage with the town council.
- **b)** Of the 65 organisations invited to one or other of the two community engagement meetings, 51 were represented by a total of 85 residents. The full list of currently identified third sector organisations active in the town is attached as Appendix A.

3) PAST PRACTICE

- a) In the past, though not for the last two years, Ventnor Town Council's assistance to the town's third sector has taken the form of a grants programme with a Budget provision ranging from £5,000-£10,000 open to organisations through a bidding process allocated by a Grants Committee.
- b) The requirements for bidding organisations to be able to submit an established constitution and annual accounts has tended to favour the better and/or longer established groups.
- c) The other significant weakness of such a process is that the assistance provided is not sustainable for any organisation if the requirement of fair distribution is complied with.

4) PROPOSAL

- a) To establish a one-year, 20-hour a week post tasked with capacity building within the town's third sector and deliver the purposes identified in 1) above.
- b) Recruitment would be from those with a community development background including experience of accessing external funding.

c) The postholder would be line managed directly by the Town Clerk with support from the informal community engagement group constituted as a Working Group of the Town Council.

5) FUNDING

a) The anticipated costs of the project are set out in the following table:
