- 2. One declaration of interest: David Baldwin declares he is the father of the Town Clerk.

3. Interpretation boards

- a. Start of walk: Steve likes the church wall but also likes the idea of being on the path as this is better for passers-by.
- All agree on the path for the location of the board in Bonchurch. Morgan to contact IOW Council
- c. Morgan to talk to sister re NT permission on Downs.
- d. Location of bench in St Lawrence permission form Twining's Morgan and Will to investigate
- e. Location of the seafront board La Falaise. David tells us that it is called Mill Bay because there were only two buildings on the sea front in 1588, one being the Mill.
- f. Morgan will scout out the locations and feed back to the group.
- g. QR codes Will and David to make PDFs of intermediatory information and a link to David's book on VTC website. Morgan to produce QR codes.
- h. A simple map of the trail to be put on each board.
- i. Steph discouraged David from putting the book for free on VTC website! Include a link to where to purchase the book?
- Suggestion of giving copies of the book to the library and asking the Heritage Centre to stock it.

4. Information Booklets

5. Flag

- a. A letter has been sent to the King of Spain to ask for permission for the design. Email address did not work.
- b. Everyone agreed that the flag design is great.
- c. Will to produce the artwork for the flag.
- d. David has secured with the previous Archdeacon for all relevant Armada churches to fly the flag. David will check this is still secured.
- e. All agreed to present a flag to John Nicolson.

6. Launch

- a. The ship is booked, signed, and paid for by David Baldwin. Ship will arrive on 21st May and
- b. It was discussed that we would like all the church bells in the area to be rung, if possible.

- c. Steph to chase Barry re portable bell.
- d. David to find out Catholic Church contacts. Brian Lucas? Does St Wilfred's have a bell?
- e. Bonchurch bell is organised. David to contact St Lawrence Church.
- f. Will Nixon to light the beacon and be on the seafront for town crying.
- g. Binnel Bay flare launched for ship to identify the start, ship to salute, Spyglass to launch flare and salute, horseshoe bay launch flare.
- h. Use concussion maroons from Stage Maroons Wells Fireworks
- i. David to collect explosives from Wells directly (Arundel) and get back to the island using the Dangerous Goods crossing?
- j. David is waiting for a reply from a Reconstruction Group about using their expertise and equipment and T2 Certificate. They will be able to move from one place to another and David will ask if Will can have a turn at firing.
